Subject: Permission to reapply for grants currently awarded to the Gulfport Police Department by the Mississippi Department of Public Safety, Division of Public Safety Planning and the University of Southern Mississippi

Your permission is requested to continue the following grant programs during the 2014-2015 fiscal year by reapplying for grant funding: (1) Alcohol Countermeasures, (2) Occupant Restraint Program, (3) Coastal Narcotics Enforcement Team Drug Task Force, (4) STOP Violence Against Women Domestic Violence Investigation Program, and (5) Project Safe Neighborhoods (6) Justice Assistance Grants for the 2014 year.

These grants with the exception of the Coastal Narcotics Enforcement Team (CNET) grant which requires a 25% cash match and STOP Violence Against Women Domestic Violence Investigation Program which requires a 25% inkind match are 75% federally funded.
