To Whom It May Concern, City of Gulfport:

The 2014 Orange Grove Mardi Gras parade is scheduled for February 15, beginning at 2:00 p.m. We have been requested to propose a new parade route. This route has been negotiated, driven and approved by the Gulfport Police Department---Chief Leonard Papania and other officers. The Orange Grove Carnival Association is requesting your approval of the new parade route.

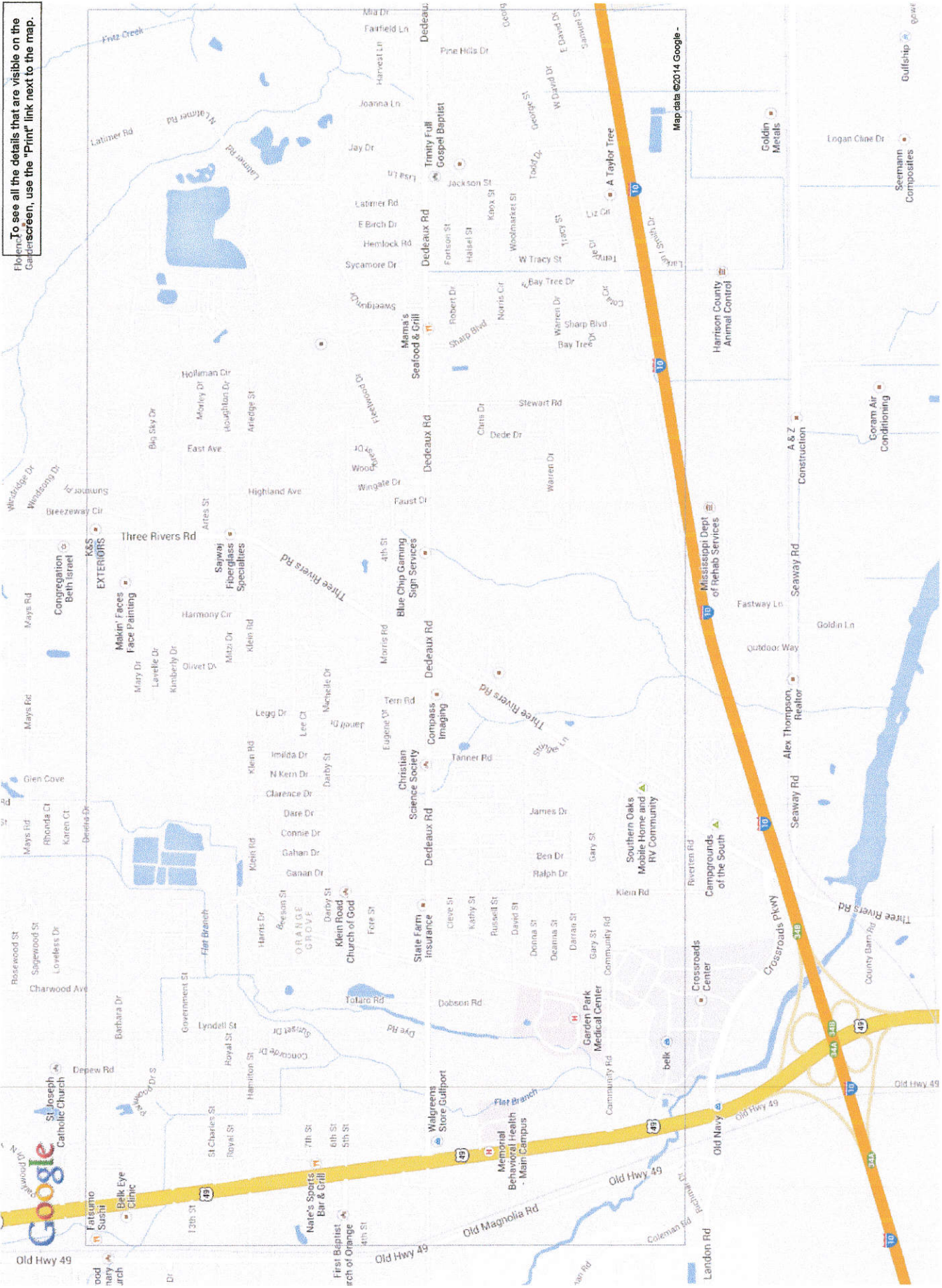
The parade will stage and originate at the Goldin Sports Complex north of Dedeaux Road. Floats will exit the Sports Complex to the north turning left onto Arledge Street which becomes Prudie Circle. It will turn left onto Three Rivers Road heading southwest and continue to Dedeaux Road. It will turn right and continue west on Dedeaux Road to Highway 49. The parade will disband at U.S. 49 and Dedeaux Road intersection. All parade vehicles and floats will be directed by police to turn right only (northbound) onto U.S. 49. Those parade vehicles wishing to turn southbound will only be allowed to do so at a traffic light controlled intersection such as St. Charles Street and Oneal Road.

We respectfully request your consideration and approval of this new parade route.
