

There came on for consideration at a duly constituted meeting of the Mayor and Members of the City Council of the City of Gulfport, Mississippi, held on the 7th day of January, 2014, the following Resolution:

**A RESOLUTION BY THE GULFPORT CITY COUNCIL AWARDED BID FOR
“TERM CONTRACT GROUP C- SUNDRY ROAD MATERIALS”, APPROVING
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GULFPORT AND LANDSHAPERS, INC.,
AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE
CITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Gulfport desires to enter into a contract for the delivery of certain commodities (Group C – Sundry Road Materials) for a stipulated price for a specified term; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to authority of this City Council, advertisements for bids were published and one (1) bid was received on the commodity noted above, with the low bidder being Landshapers, Inc., as referenced in the Memorandum of Connie Debenport and tabulation sheet which is contained among those documents attached hereto as Exhibit “A”; and

WHEREAS, a proposed Agreement Between The City Of Gulfport And Commodity Supplier On The Basis Of A Stipulated Price, is contained among those documents attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:**

Section 1. That the matters, facts and things recited in the Preamble hereto are hereby adopted as the official findings of the Governing Authority.

Section 2. That the proposed Agreement Between The City Of Gulfport And Commodity Supplier On The Basis Of A Stipulated Price, be and it is hereby approved in the form as attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City of Gulfport.

Section 3. That this Resolution be, and it is hereby ordered to be spread on the minutes of the governing Authority, and to be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and enactment according to law.

The above and foregoing Resolution, after having been first reduced to writing and ready by the Clerk, was introduced by Councilmember Walker, seconded by Councilmember Casey, and was adopted by the following roll call vote:


