The City of Gulfport (LPA) intends to employ a consulting engineering firm to provide construction engineering and inspection (CE&I) services utilizing a Cost plus Fixed Fee, Labor Hour/Unit Price or Lump Sum/Firm Fixed Price contract for the Widening of 28th Street Project. The project will include widening, overlay, and other improvements to 28th Street from 22nd Avenue to 34th Avenue, Project No. STP-9098-00(002)LPA / 105418-701000, Harrison County, Mississippi. The Consultant is required to assume the duties and responsibilities of construction engineering inspection, testing of materials, contract administration and other related activities necessary to properly oversee all construction activities in accordance with MDOT Local Public Agency Project Development Manual process.

- 3. A description of similar type work completed during the past five (5) years which qualifies the consultant for this work; the cost and schedule completion (or actual completion) of this work;
- 4. A response containing the information upon which the consultant will be evaluated; and,

- 5. The consultant's size and capability of staff to perform this work in accordance with an expedited progress schedule, considering the firm's current and planned workload.

The LPA reserves the right to select one (1) consultant or select a short list of consultants from whom more information will be required.

The LPA reserves the right to reject any and all Proposals and/or to discontinue contract execution with any party at any time prior to final contract execution.
