Dear City Council Members:

Last summer, the Mississippi Steel Magnolias Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure®, a breast cancer foundation, held its first Gulf Coast event, Paint the Park Pink. Due to the overwhelming community support of this event, Paint the Park Pink will be replaced by a new event. The Mississippi Steel Magnolias will be holding the first annual *Race for the Cure Mississippi Gulf Coast* is part of the largest series of 5K runs/fitness walks in the world. Race for the Cure promotes breast health awareness, celebrates survivors, encourages breast cancer patients and honors those we have lost. The event is scheduled for the morning of Saturday, September 6th at Jones Park in Gulfport. With breast cancer affecting one in eight women and its occurrence in men continuing to rise, we feel that it is vital to involve all of our communities in the fight against breast cancer.

With this being a Race for the Cure, will have more participants and need a route that is more user friendly to the walkers and runners. The route will begin and end in front of the downtown post office. I have spoken to Larry, the postmaster, and he is in support of the Race route. We are asking the City to close 13th street only. Please see the attached route. We look forward to discussing this further on the 8th at the Council meeting.

Formed in 1982, Susan G. Komen launched the global breast cancer movement. Thanks to events nationwide, we have invested almost \$2 billion to fulfill our promise, working to end breast cancer in the U.S. and throughout the world through groundbreaking research, community health outreach, advocacy and programs in more than 50 countries. Over 2.75 million has been redistributed back into Mississippi to provide breast health services for many uninsured and under-insured individuals needing care. Up to **75 percent** of the net income from Mississippi Steel Magnolias' events stays in Mississippi to fund breast health education and breast cancer screening and treatment projects. A minimum of 25 percent of net income from events supports the Komen for the Cure Award and Research Grant Programs, which fund groundbreaking breast cancer research, meritorious awards and educational and scientific conferences around the world to include the discovery of the BRCA I & II gene and lifesaving Herceptin therapy.
