NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the matters, facts, and things recited in the Preamble hereto are hereby adopted as the official findings of the Governing Authority.

SECTION 2. That the proposed changes to the contract are necessary and/or incidental to the completion of the work as originally bid, are not outside the scope of the original contract, are commercially reasonable and not made to circumvent the public purchasing statutes.

SECTION 3. That the INCREASE in costs to the City and the INCREASE in contract time are reasonable in light of all relevant facts and circumstances.

SECTION 4. That Change Order #2 to the City's contract with VISION

CONSTRUCTORS, INC., for the GULFPORT CENTENNIAL MUSEUM PROJECT be and it is hereby approved, in the form as is found in Exhibit "A" to this resolution, and the Mayor is, hereby, authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City of Gulfport.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage and enactment according to law, and shall be spread upon the minutes of the Gulfport City Council.
