There came on for consideration at a duly constituted meeting of the City Council and Mayor of the City of Gulfport held on the 22nd day of April, 2014, the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 2790

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL TEXT OF THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI ADOPTED THE 29TH DAY OF JUNE, 1979, SECTION III DISTRICT REGULATIONS, (J) CHART OF PERMITTED USES, (2) SCHEDULE OF USES TO BE AMENDED TO ALLOW A SHOOTING RANGE WITH PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVAL IN AN I-3 ZONING DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gulfport, Mississippi, find and do so determine, based upon the recommendation of the Gulfport City Planning Commission, that the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance should be amended to allowed with Planning Commission Approval in an I-3 zoning district to the existing Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance. The case file number is 1403PC009.

On Page 1530.1 in Appendix A – Zoning, Section III District Regulations, (J) Chart of Permitted Uses, (2) Schedule of uses, should be amended under "Cultural, Entertainment, Recreation" to allow with Planning Commission Approval in an I-3 zoning district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the official text of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Gulfport, adopted the 29th day of June, 1979, be and the same is hereby amended to Cultural, Entertainment, Recreation, to allowed with Planning Commission Approval in B-2 and B-4 and I-3 zoning districts, as follows:
